## OUR MISSION

The Waupaca County Veterans Services Office is often the initial contact for all veterans' services. This office consists of the County Veterans Service Officer and professional Veterans Benefit Specialists who perform a critical role in providing education about federal and state veterans' benefits to all communities located within the boundaries of Waupaca County. The Veterans Services Office is committed to providing vital and efficient services to veterans, their dependents, and survivors. This office provides support to approximately 5,500 veterans and their families.

The Waupaca County Veterans Service Office promotes legislation and policy at both the state and federal levels. This legislation and policy is supportive of veterans' rights and issues and is in harmony with the national obligation to veterans of the United States armed forces.

The Waupaca County Service Office is committed to fostering a mutually beneficial relationship for the common good of all veterans. It is the intent of this office to secure all veterans' benefits, for which they are entitled by law and moral obligation, by providing assistance and education to the veterans and their families.



## FEDERAL VA BENEFITS

- ◆ **VA Health Care** - available to veterans that meet eligibility criteria
- ◆ **Veterans Pension** - often wrongly referred to as Aid & Attendance Benefit - eligibility based upon FINANCIAL NEED, war-time service, disability, and age. Widows(ers) of war-time veterans may also qualify
- ◆ **Disability Compensation** - for veterans with current illnesses and/or disabilities incurred or aggravated by their military service
- ◆ **Educational Allowances** - Montgomery GI Bill, Post 9/11 GI Bill, Reserve Educational Assistance Program, Veterans Retraining Assistance Program and others
- ◆ **Burial Benefits** - grave markers, burial flags, Presidential Memorial Certificates and financial burial allowance may be available
- ◆ **Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC)** - widows/widowers of veterans that died due to service connected conditions or have held 100% service connected ratings for 10 years, may be eligible for financial benefits
- ◆ **Government Life Insurance Policies** - beneficiary changes, death claims
- ◆ **Vocational Rehabilitation** - for veterans with service connected disabilities
- ◆ **VA Home Loan Guaranty Program**  
Certificates of Eligibility

## WI VETERANS BENEFITS

- ◆ **Wisconsin GI Bill** - for those that entered the military from Wisconsin. May be available to spouses and children of 30% or higher service connected disabled veterans.
- ◆ **Education Benefits** - Retraining Grant, Vet Ed Grant
- ◆ **Property Tax Credit** for 100% service connected veterans with at least five years of Wisconsin residency
- ◆ **Wisconsin Veterans Homes**
  - \* King
  - \* Union Grove
  - \* Chippewa Falls
- ◆ **Wisconsin Veterans Memorial Cemeteries**
  - \* King
  - \* Union Grove
  - \* Spooner
- ◆ **Veterans Assistance Program** - Transitional housing for veterans who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless
- ◆ **Aid to Needy Veterans Grant** - Hearing aids, eye glasses or dental grants for state veterans without assets and insurance and an inability to pay for these services
- ◆ **Free or Discounted Park Pass and Fishing Licenses** - for 70% or higher service connected veterans
